

How to Compare Energy Offers

What to Look For



Price Per Unit

For electric, it's shown as \$/kWh.
For gas, it can be shown as \$/MCF or \$/CCF. This is the price per unit you will pay for the gas or electricity you use.



Rate Type

Check if the rate is fixed, meaning it stays the same for the length of the term, or variable, meaning the rate can fluctuate.



Introductory Price

Is the price you are being offered only available for a limited time?



Term Length

The amount of time you are locked into the contract.



Early Termination Fee

The fee you will pay if you switch suppliers before the contract term ends.



Monthly Fee

Some suppliers charge an additional monthly fee
